1. How can we find a partner institution?

As a first step to finding a partner institution, we suggest joining the 100K Innovation Network at <https://www.100kstrongamericas.org/innovation-network/> to gain access to our member directory of over 2,300 higher education institutions or reading our list of HEIs Interested in Forming Potential Partnerships, which we send out after each webinar. We also post these lists on our network. Another great resource we recommend is finding an EducationUSA Advising Center at <https://educationusa.state.gov/find-advising-center>.

2. Is there a language requirement for students to travel?.

No, there is no language requirement for students to travel, but we always recommend having some aspect of language learning in your proposals to help students prepare for and feel comfortable on their exchanges.
